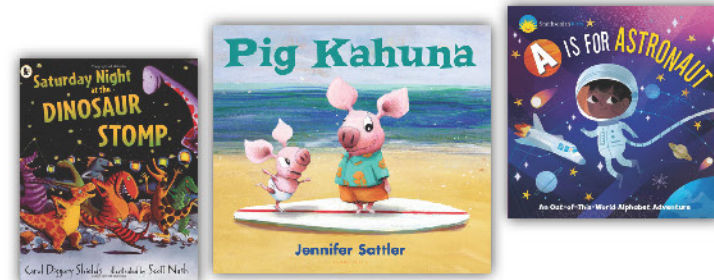

Week 1: July 11, 12, 13
Ages: 7-12 years old

DINOSAURS

How to Draw your Dinosaur

July 11, 12, 13 | Time: 10:00 am to noon | Class fee: \$50

Explore different prehistoric dinosaurs and learn the basics of drawing and painting to create your own dinosaur masterpiece

Clay Fossils

July 11, 12, 13 | Time: 10:00 am to noon | Class fee: \$50

Come and learn the basics of working with clay while creating textures and impressions that look like real fossils as well as other dinosaur inspired artworks.

Paper Maché

July 11, 12, 13 | Time: 1 pm to 3 pm | Class fee: \$50

Many different kinds of dinosaurs walked the planet thousands of years ago. Do you have a favorite? Each student will sculpt their favorite animal out of recycled materials, paper mache and paint.



Dino Prints

What is printmaking? Come and learn the basics of this ancient art form and how to create a work of art that can be printed or stamped over and over again. We will draw, carve, paint and color our works of art inspired by Dinosaurs.

OUTER SPACE

CLAY Space Creatures

July 18, 19, 20 | Time: 10 am to noon | Class fee: \$50

Learn the pinch, coil, and slab clay techniques while creating make-believe space creatures and outer space inspired projects with self-hardening and fired clay.

Galactic Jewelry

July 18, 19, 20 | Time: 10 am to noon | Class fee: \$50

Design and create futuristic astronaut jewelry, asteroid belts and accessories from a variety of beads, metal wire, paint, and recycled material. Great for boys and girls!

Drawing in Space

July 18, 19, 20

Time: 1 pm to 3 pm

Class fee: \$50

Learn the basics in drawing while studying planets, stars, and flying space crafts. Paint, oil pastels and a variety of drawing materials will be used to create depth in our deep space artworks.

Outer Space - Maker Space

July 18, 19, 20 | Time: 1 pm to 3 pm | Class fee: \$50

Do you like to build? This class will encourage the student's creative freedom with a 'daily challenge.' Wood, tape measures, hot glue, recycled materials and much more will be available to construct sculptures and unique inventions.

Ocean Adventures

Under the Sea

July 25, 26, 27 | Time: 10 am to noon

Class fee: \$50

Students will create paintings and drawings of oceanscapes and sea life with a variety of materials including oil pastels, glitter and metallic paints.

3-D Ocean Creatures

July 25, 26, 27

Time: 10 am to noon

Class fee: \$50

Bring your imaginary sea creature(s) to life by building a 3-dimensional version using recycled materials and paint.

CLAY - Ocean Animals

July 25, 26, 27 | Time: 1 pm to 3 pm | Class fee: \$50

The sea is full of animal and plant shapes that are perfect for creating out of clay. After learning the basics of working with clay, create your favorite sea creature in self-hardening and fired clay.

Under the Sea - Action Painting

July 25, 26, 27 | Time: 1 pm to 3 pm | Class fee: \$50

Splash! Splash! Splat! Learn about artist Jackson Pollock and create paintings inspired by his drip and splatter techniques. Students should wear old clothes and shoes and plan to spend part of the day outside painting, weather permitting.

CLAY CAMP

August 1, 2, 3 | 10:30 am – 12:30 pm* | Class fee: \$50

Clay Camp is a unique pottery program offering a total hands-on experience in a variety of ceramic techniques, incorporating hand-building, throwing on the wheel, glazing and firing. Class size is limited and designed for individual instruction. No clay experience required; beginners welcome!

*The clay studio is open in the afternoon to enrolled students who wish to continue working independently.
