

- If you are submitting images in more than one medium, you must submit a separate application and fee for each category.
- Include with your application 6 .jpg images (5 art/craft photos + 1 booth photo) on a nonreturnable USB flashdrive - OR - email images to vonda@cedarhurst.org
- If you are accepted for the 2024 Cedarhurst Art & Craft Fair you will be notified by **APRIL 3, 2024** and your Booth Fee (see sizes and fees on the registration form) is due by **JUNE 1, 2024**.
- Artists who notify Cedarhurst of their intent to cancel by <u>July 1, 2024</u> will be refunded 75% of the booth fee. There is no refund due to inclement weather.

 Fair Jury Committee reserves the right to view each booth after set-up and request that any work
 not meeting the above listed guidelines be removed.
