REGISTRATION: Registrations are taken in order received with payment. Deadline to enroll for each class is one week before the class begins. Classes are limited in size to 12 students per class. Spaces cannot be reserved without payment. For your convenience, payments (by major credit card) are accepted by phone or you may register online at www.cedarhurst.org

LUNCHTIME Art Activity: Fee: \$10.00 per week
(Tues, Wed, Thurs. noon-1:00 p.m)

Students bring their own lunch and have fun creating a different art project each day. Weather permitting, activities could include walks in the sculpture park, daily craft projects, group mural, or a visit to the museum galleries and family center.

Ages 7 to 12 years old

Dinosaur Drawing & Painting

Time: 10 am - 12 pm | Class fee: \$60

Get ready for a ROARING fun art class as students learn the basics of drawing and painting while studying pictures of different dinosaurs and the environments where they lived. Markers, paint, oil pastels and more will be used to create dino-mite prehistoric masterpieces!

Clay Fossils

Time: 10 am - 12 pm
Class fee: \$60

Make a good impression! Come and learn the basics of clay while creating textures and impressions that look like real fossils in clay. Our fossil plaques and bowls will be fired in the kiln. Air-dry clay will be used to model small, dino figurines and their environment.

Explore the art of printmaking! Discover how to create multiple images of your artwork using ink, brayers, 'plates' and paper. We'll begin with simple, black and white prints, then experiment with color mixing to create beautiful works of art on paper.

Fiber & Book Arts

Time: 10 am - 12 pm | Class fee: \$60

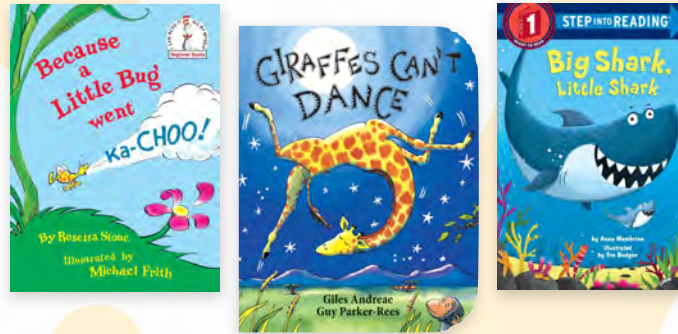
